This programme helps students form an interdisciplinary attitude towards the humanities problems, and offers good language training, as well as highly qualified academic advising. Training in postgraduate programmes guarantees access to research collaboration with the leading scientists of the Ural region.

Graduates of this programme can pursue professions of researchers, teachers, specialists in culture and education, or experts and analysts in the history of Russia. The fields of professional activity: conducting research in research organisations and institutions of higher education in the field of the history of Russia; conducting research and educational activities in cultural institutions, archives, museums, exhibition complexes related to the history of Russia; educational and popularization activities in mass media, public and state organisations related to the history of Russia.
